

Bagpiper Francis Wallace / Funerals Baltimore, Maryland

What does a bagpiper do at a Church Funeral / Memorial Service?

- Play outside to greet Family and Guest's as they enter a Church.
- Processional music for the Service
- A Musical Selection during the ceremony for Lighting of the Candles or Special Remembrance. It may be possible to perform with the organist, pianist or other musicians in attendance.
- Play the coffin out as the Ceremony ends, and people go to their cars to get into the receiving line.

What does a bagpiper do at a Cemetery?

- Play as Car Procession enters the Cemetery until everyone is at Graveside.
- After the Priest, Minister or Rabi and Military Honors, Play "Amazing Grace" or Song of Choice.
- Play after the Immediate Family has left the Graveside Ceremony and while cars are recessing from the cemetery
